I have finally found some very good glow tinsel to do this with. We call them the "Glow Core Bucktail Jigs". The nice thing about these jigs is the glow tinsel is a bright color without being charged with light. We have tested these jigs and have caught fish with and without charging the jig so they can work either way. There are several fish catching colors to choose from to give you an edge in both night and sun light conditions.




Bucktail Flies

Bucktail flies have been a well-kept secret for the past few years by some of the touring pros on the Walleye circuits.

Our flies can be pulled singly or in tandem. We use a #2 sharp hook and all of our many colors are hand-tied. Bottom bouncers, three-ways, or just a couple split-shots in front can produce quality catches. These can also be run with a jig or crankbait as well.

Glitter Crappie Kips

Some of you may remember years ago we had a line of kip tail jigs for panfish. When the old boy that tied all of these pass away I just drop the line having no one to tie them up. Several shops have been after me for years to bring them back, so we did. Got a bunch of nice looking colors that have been tested, a lot by me, and they all work fantastic for crappie, gills and perch. We put these on a extra sharp red sickle hook in 3 perfect size weights. The pan fisherman will be very excited about these! 1\24oz & 1\16oz with #6 hook and 1/8oz with #4 hook.



Glitter Crappie Jigs

For many years I have been making this little jewel of a jig for myself and few close friends for pan fishing. We use a extra sharp black nickel sickle hook and have this jig in 4 different weights. Four fish catching colors that fish have a very hard time throwing the hook on, especially perch. With the glitter head no matter if it's clear or dirty water the fish will seek this bright jig out. Tell your customers they better have a pair of pliers because these hooks don't like to let go.

Holographic & Painted Hawg Spoons

This lure has been around a long time and has proven itself to be a fish-catching machine. Casting and swimming it, vertically jigging it, casting and jigging it like a jig, or dropping and holding it are some of the methods that make this lure a real winner. Always tie directly to the wire form near the eye as using this with a snap takes away a lot of action.





Sauger Slayer

Ok let's talk flukes. About 10 years ago or so when I first started fishing the fluke I didn't know what to expect. As much as I hate to say it considering I've been pitching ringworms for over 20 years now. If I was stuck with only using one of the two for walleyes\saugers it would be the fluke believe it or not. It's the hardest piece of plastic that I have to try to convince people to try. But I will tell you that 99 % of the people I get to try a fluke have come back multiple times and bought more and that's a fact! So we have come up with some custom colors that are simply awesome. The nice thing about this body is that there are groves in the body behind the dorsal fin. So this tail gets side to side action in it. We have nick named this tail the Sauger Slayer. The main thing here is to make sure you try some of these because if you don't you have just plain miss the boat!!!



Wally Wackers

Well it took a while to get this done but we now finally have a "WALLY WACKER". Comparing this to the Sauger Slayer it is 1\4 inch longer, a little bit wider and deeper. The big difference is the tail. Now it has a small tail just like a ringworm. With just the slightest of movement the tail has excellent action. The tail is also in the upward position so dragging or pumping this on the bottom produces good tail vibration. With 5 new colors to choose from it's hard to decide which color to try first. Not only is this a great piece of plastic for walleye and sauger. Smallmouth love to munch on these. It's a new version of plastic that needs to be in everyone's tackle box. There will be more colors coming in the near future.



Wally Bangers

For several years a lot of my loyal customers, tournament fisherman and some guides I know have been after me to come up with a bigger piece of plastic. We now have what should make everyone happy. We have named it "Hutchies-Wally-Banger". What you have here is basically a fluke body, my personal favorite pieces of plastic, especially for big fish. This body then ends up with a ring worm tail. This is a true 5 inch body but its streamlined and looks as natural as a true big minnow swimming through the water.

They're made with virgin plastic so there nice and soft for the finicky bites and the tail is up so you can drag it slowly and still get good action. We have 9 different fish catching colors to choose from with more coming. In good current or snap jigging you get action from both the back half of the tail sweeping from side to side as well as the curl tail on the end. Believe me when I tell you that this is without a doubt a tail that has to be in your box no matter what season it is.

Here is one other thing we've added too. A normal jig will without a doubt work with these bigger tails. But we have made some special jigs for these bigger pieces of plastic. Our normal hook size for a $1\8 \$ $3\16$ is a $1\0$. Most manufacturers use a # 1 but we are offering these two sizes in a $3\0$ hook. For a $1\4$, $3\8 \$ $1\2$ we use a $2\0$ but now you can get them with a $4\0$ hook. These are great for any type of big bulky baits. You can look at the comparison chart below to get a better idea. We will sell the $1\8$, $3\16\14$, $3\8 \$ $1\2$ in either plain lead, gold on top silver on the bottom or purple on top and silver on the bottom. These will be the only colors we will have at this time.



Soft Body Shads

Here's a piece of plastic that's been around a long time: the 3" shad body. It's been forgotten with all of the new plastic over the past couple years, but make no mistake, this is a fish-catching machine.

I love fishing this in the fall and winter. When casting it, I personally like to snap jig it back. You will get bites that almost rip the rod right out of your hand. When vertical jigging it, I like to drop it to the bottom, pick it up a couple inches, and then hold it still. The fish will come up and just plain crush it.

I have some of the good old dependable colors as well as a few custom colors to choose from. This is also a dynamite lure for the smallies in the Spring and Fall when they are staging on the rock. Try some, you won't be disappointed.



Paddle Tails

We have brought on another style of plastic. This one has been around along time and has a proven record of catching walleye, sauger as well as many other species of fish on a regular basis. 2 of the many different ways to fish this durable tail are to be fish on a jig, or on a plain hook on a 3 way. We have 6 colors to start with and plan on adding more in the near future.



We begin with a molded head that won't tip to the side no matter how fast you reel it. We use a razor-sharp hook followed by a superior finish. Unlike a lot of jig manufacturers, our jigs have full-bodied skirts. We have 61 different colors to choose from. All of the swim jigs have a plastic grub keeper. When you slide the grub over the wire, it's going to stay there. Our line of 5" grubs is a perfect match for these jigs. Available in 1/4 oz.

Swim Jig Grubs

Here we have a true 5-inch tail. The grubs are made with virgin plastic and so are as soft as can be.

As the actual tail comes out of the body, it's nice and wide, then it gradually chokes down to a fine tip. Now you have a tail that has a wide wobble that eventually at the tip of the tail has a very fine, aggressive action to it — the best of both worlds!



Flippin' Jigs

With the tapered head design this jigs goes through the weeds just as good as the wood. The head is also designed to stand up when sitting still making it easier for fish to pick it up. We use a Gamakatsu hook and all jigs have hand tied skirts and a grub keeper wire built in. This style of jig has been copied many times but never duplicated. Only available in 3\8.


Glitter Crappie Kips

So after countless color combinations here are 10 new colors we created and tested this past year. All of the colors work very good on crappies, perch and bluegills. We also elected to go back to a gold hook on these new jigs and added a couple new colors of stripes.

We call # 36 dirty perch because it looks just like a perch that has spent a lot of time in the weeds. 37 looks like black, white θ chart. But when you tilt the blade just a 1/8 of an inch it takes on a milky bluish tint. #7 is a mock up or the red craw color. 39 just speaks for itself, just an awesome color. All of these colors have produced good numbers since we got them in not too long ago. These colors are available in both 1/4 and 1/2oz
